



### Directions for the *Do it Yourself Ring-Pin*

1. Cut along dotted lines. Slice the dotted lines marked \*.
2. Cut around each pin (as shown in diagram) with a blade. Make sure to leave the pin attached to the *pin cushion form*.
3. Mountain fold along the dash-dot lines.
4. Put glue on the largest glue area. Make a cylinder with the *pin cushion form* by attaching the end opposite the largest glue area to the largest glue area.
5. Thread the *soon-to-be ring band* through one slit marked \* into the cylinder, and then out the other slit marked \*.
6. Pull the *soon-to-be ring band* until about 1 in/ 2.5 cm of the glue end of the band is sticking out of the cylinder, and about 9 in/ 23 cm is sticking out the other side of the cylinder.
7. Repeat step 5 several times, creating the ring band.
8. Glue the ring band ends in place.
9. Put glue on the four small glue areas. Attach the folded tabs to these glue areas creating a pillow-like form. Now you have made the pin cushion.
10. Use your blade to pull the pins up, and make a gentle fold where they meet the *pin cushion form*.
11. When dry, place on finger.
